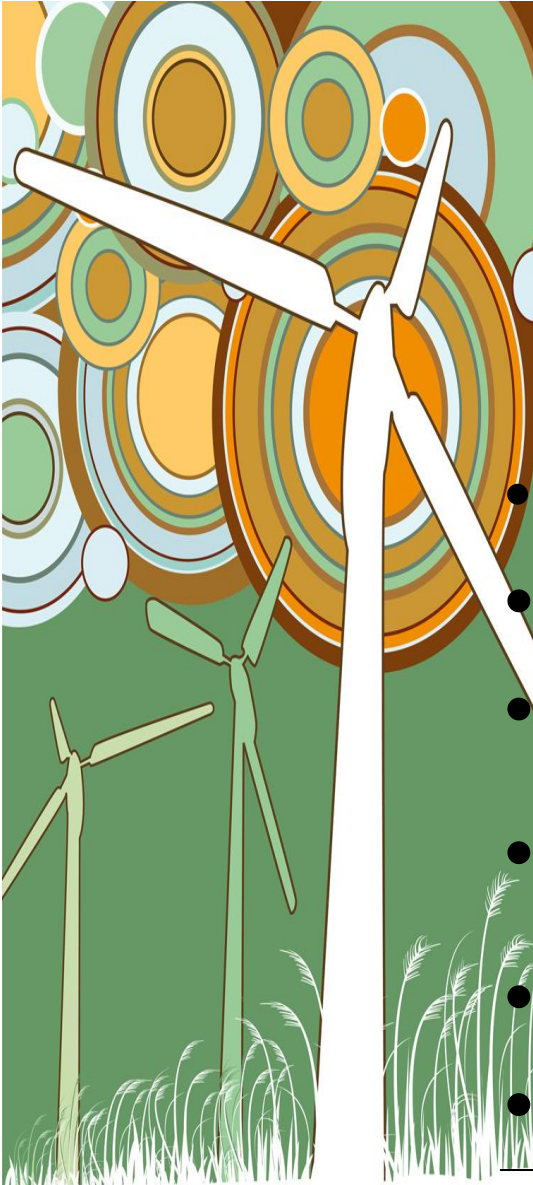

**Let's Shut Chicago's Coal Plants Down by 2010!**

- Show your support to the USEPA in their lawsuit against the Coal Plant Owners (Midwest Gen.) and demand they meet current standards!
- The Chicago neighborhoods of Little Village and Pilsen are home to 2 of the dirtiest coal plants in the nation, upgraded last in the 1950s.
- Chicago's asthma rates are twice the national average. Pollution from the plants is attributed to 40 deaths by asthma annually, 550 ER visits, and 2,800 asthma attacks per year.
- Latino populations in Chicago have a mortality rate 5 times higher than that of white populations, thanks in part to the Fisk and Crawford coal plants.
- Coal mining destroys mountains, pollutes communities, and ruins entire eco-systems.
- Coal is the single biggest source of carbon emissions driving global warming.
